



## Tennessee Soybean Festival

### Junior Art Contest

##### Rules & Regulations:

1. Exhibitors must be a resident of Martin or attend a Martin school.
2. Entry time: **Tuesday, August 22, 3:30-5:00 & Thursday, August 24, 3:30-5:00 at Martin City Hall**
3. There will be 4 groups of competition based on grade for 2017/2018 school year:
  - a. Grade K-2<sup>nd</sup>
  - b. Grade 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>
  - c. Grade 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>
  - d. Grade 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>
4. **All art should be drawn directly on blank, 5x8 inch index cards.**
5. Each student may submit a total of 2 items into the art contest.
6. **Items entered for competition must have been made entirely by the person entering the contest.**
7. Only hand drawn or hand painted work will be accepted. No “spin art” and no tracings.
8. Each entry MUST have the following information clearly written or typed on the back: exhibitor’s name, phone #, address, school, current grade.
9. All entries must use the theme “Homegrown” as it relates to agriculture as the theme. (This means anything agriculture is included- farm field, farm implement, farm storage, farm food, etc.)
10. Art items will be displayed downtown, Tuesday-Saturday of the festival.
11. After the festival, submissions may be picked up at Martin City Hall, September 13-15 from 10 am- 4 pm. Any items not picked up will be disposed of.
12. The Tennessee Soybean Festival is not responsible for damage or loss of submitted art.

##### **Awards will be given for each age group as follows:**

**Best of Show- \$20**

**1<sup>st</sup> Place- \$15**

**2<sup>nd</sup> place- \$10**

**3<sup>rd</sup> place- \$5**
