

TN Soybean Festival Community Art Competition RULES

The theme is “*Growing Community Through Art*”

Registration required. \$25 registration fee. Register in person at the Martin City Hall from July 1 – August 23, 2019. Fee includes one (1) 3x3 foot art board to be picked up at Martin City Hall. Artists have to supply their own paint. Funds raised will cover the costs of the boards and for the beautification of the Brian Brown Memorial Greenway.

All boards must be returned to the Martin City Hall no later than Friday, August 23rd by 12 noon to be displayed, and voted on, along the Brian Brown Memorial Greenway’s new extension during this year’s TN Soybean Festival, September 1-7, 2019.

Each piece of art will have a corresponding number. All festival attendees and community members can vote using a ballot box (set-up at either end of the greenway) or cast their paper vote at Martin City Hall.

The winner will be announced during the final evening of the TN Soybean Festival with the opportunity to win \$100 cash prizes under three separate categories: individual, family, group.

Art pieces will be attached along the black fenced around along the new portion of the Brian Brown Greenway extension area. Pieces will have pre-cut holes and use zip ties to attach to the fence. Directional signs will also be used to inspire folks to take a walk, view and vote for the artwork.

To enter the contest, register at the Martin City Hall in person. Pick up your board from the Martin City Hall from July 1 – August 23, 2019. **Deadline to submit finished artwork is Friday, August 23, 2019 by 12 NOON.**

****Painting can be oil, acrylic or mixed media****

****Submitted piece should be fixed in a medium that can sustain the outdoor environment and submitted dry****

****Include title, artist/family/group full name, category (individual, family, group) and materials used with each submitted piece (can be written on the back of the board)****

HOW TO VOTE

Your art will be displayed, photographed and posted on the [TN Soybean Festival Facebook](#) page. Active voting will take place between September 1 – 7th, by casting ballots in designated boxes along the Greenway Art Corridor, or submitted in person to the Martin City Hall. An active voting day is scheduled for Saturday, September 7th from 8am -4pm. The paintings with the most individual votes will be the winner!

Voting will conclude on September 7, 2019 at 4pm. Winners will be announced that evening.

THE PRIZE

Categories: Individual, Family and Group will each receive a prize of \$100.
